It is not too late to register for Presbyterians for Earth Care's national conference, September 20-23. In addition to joining virtually, there are three options to participate live in Minneapolis, Little Rock and Berkeley. <u>https://presbyearthcare.org/2023-</u> <u>conference/</u> *Registration for the main site in Massanetta Springs, VA is closed.* The worship services, Bible studies and 20+ workshops are all being streamed live at our satellite locations and online.

The Rev. Dr. Diane Moffett (president and executive director of the Presbyterian Mission Agency) will preach for two worship services, the Rev. Dr. Patricia Tull (author of the 2024-2025 PW Bible study) will lead the Bible studies, top scientists like long-time NO-AA oceanographer Mark Eakin, seminary professors, pastors, activists, and concerned Christians will gather to learn, share and organize.

As the earth continues to warm, wildfires and droughts become more frequent, and flooding and landslides from heavy rainfall happen more often, God's children all over the world continue to suffer. This conference is intended to inspire hope while addressing what individuals and organizations can do to slow the climate crisis.
