FPC welcomed our new pastor, the Rev. Betsy Jay, February 1. Betsy may be familiar to some.

A minister of Word and sacrament, she has been a member of the Presbytery of Utica for over 40 years, filling pulpits and serving congregations throughout the presbytery as stated supply or interim pastor.

Betsy was also chaplain at Bassett Medical Center in Cooperstown from 2007 to the end of 2019. Most recently, she has moderated the session at FPC and led worship several times since Pastor Rick Riggle resigned. In addition, she currently serves as moderator of Utica Presbytery and as a trustee.

Betsy grew up in Bethesda, MD and still has memories of Church School classes going back to when she was a preschooler. The church was part of her extended family.
