When I was four and for a number of years later, I knew only one thing about Lent. It was not about fasting or giving something up. It was not about the color purple. Nor was it about the devil tempting Jesus in the wilderness. The only thing I knew about Lent was that there was a special offering called the One Great Hour of Sharing.

One Sunday in early spring, we were given cardboard banks in the shape of a church (not a fish) in Church School. Throughout the next six weeks I would put pennies and even nickels in the bank. I learned that all that we gave, however little or however much, would help people in need, especially those who were hungry or refugees or whose homes and lives had been turned upside down in disaster and war. For people in the church, including children like me, there could hardly be a better way to follow in the footsteps of Jesus than to show our care and love for others by generously giving all we could. And it was wonderful to see a shelf full of little cardboard church banks and I set my bank on the shelf beside them on Palm Sunday or Easter.

The One Great Hour of Sharing was introduced in 1946, after the end of the World War II as an ecumenical effort to raise one million dollars in one hour for world relief. It really got going in 1949 (75 years ago) with a broadcast that included President Truman, leaders from a number of denominations, and other well known folks. Since then, there have been changes, but the essential purpose remains the same: to collect a special offering for those in need.

The PCUSA raises funds for hunger relief; building dignity through self-development of peoples; and providing assistance in disasters and their aftermath. In fact, over the past decade, communities and congregations in Herkimer and Oneida counties in Utica Presbytery have received disaster assistance. That includes us, First Presbyterian Church of Ilion. PDA gave us a grant to help rebuild the basement after flooding. Think about what this congregation has been able to do as a result, the impact in serving the community through meals and wellness.

It has been many decades since I dedicated my first offering to OGHS. It matters even more now to provide relief in scarcity and the distress of violence, war, and hatred. Please join in this offering for our troubled world. Cardboard fish and envelopes abound for the taking. We will dedicate our OGHS offering on Easter Sunday.
